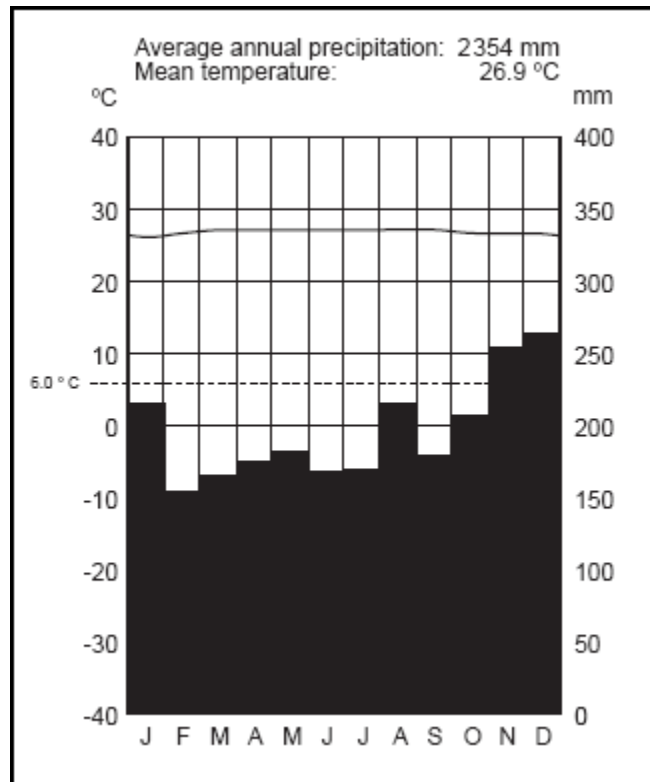
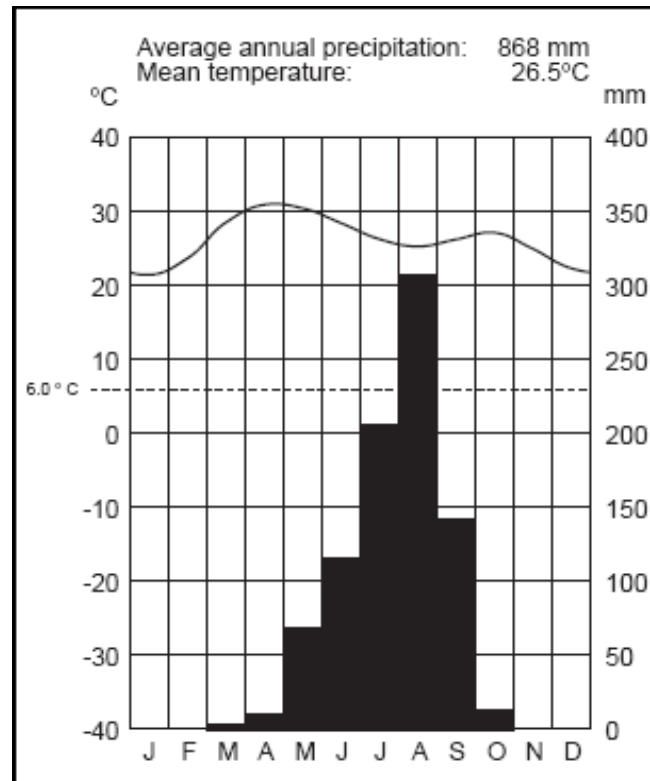


Tropical Climates: Warm Temperatures all year.

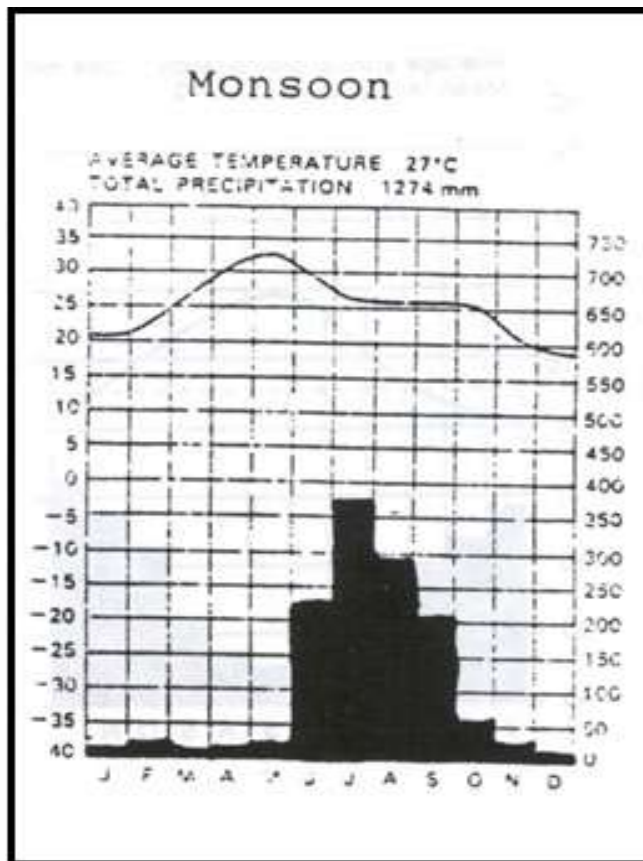

Tropical Wet / Dry



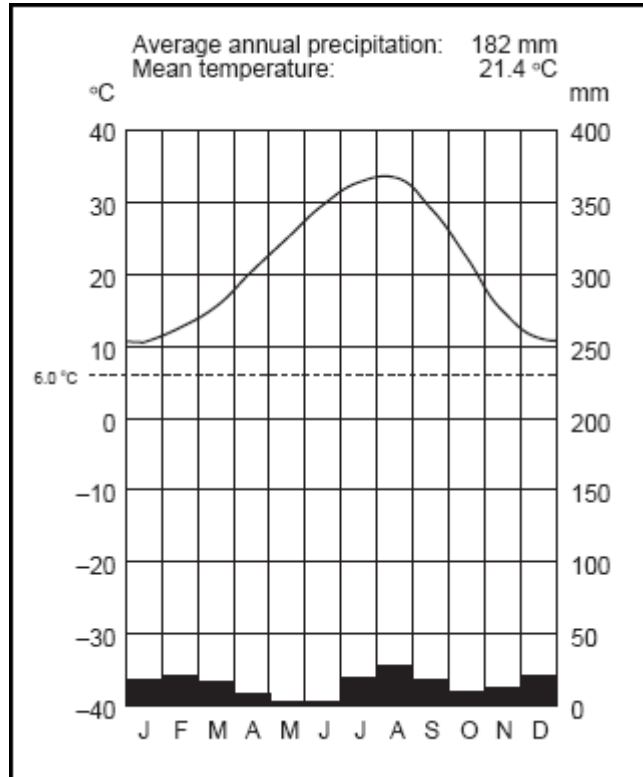
Monsoon



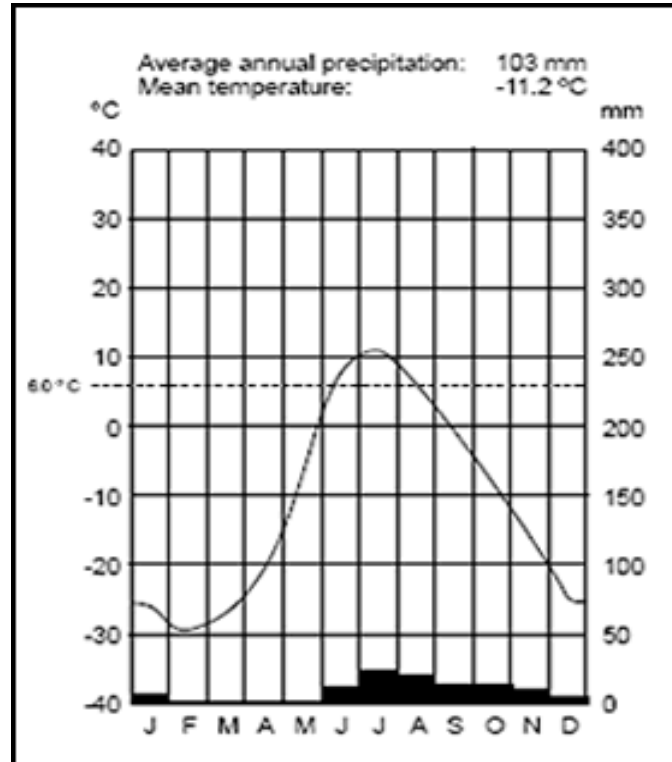

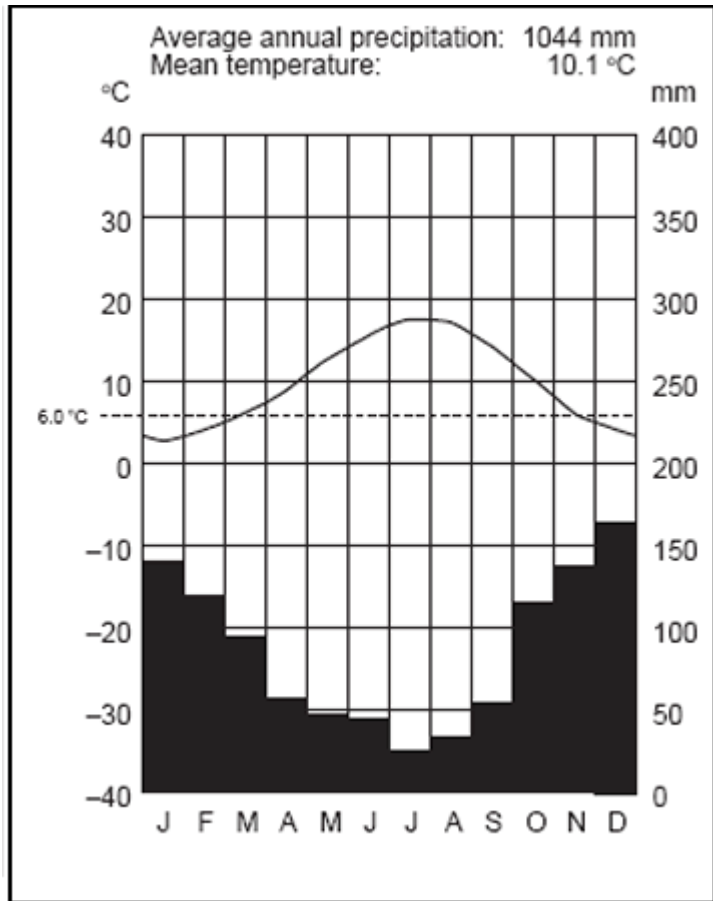

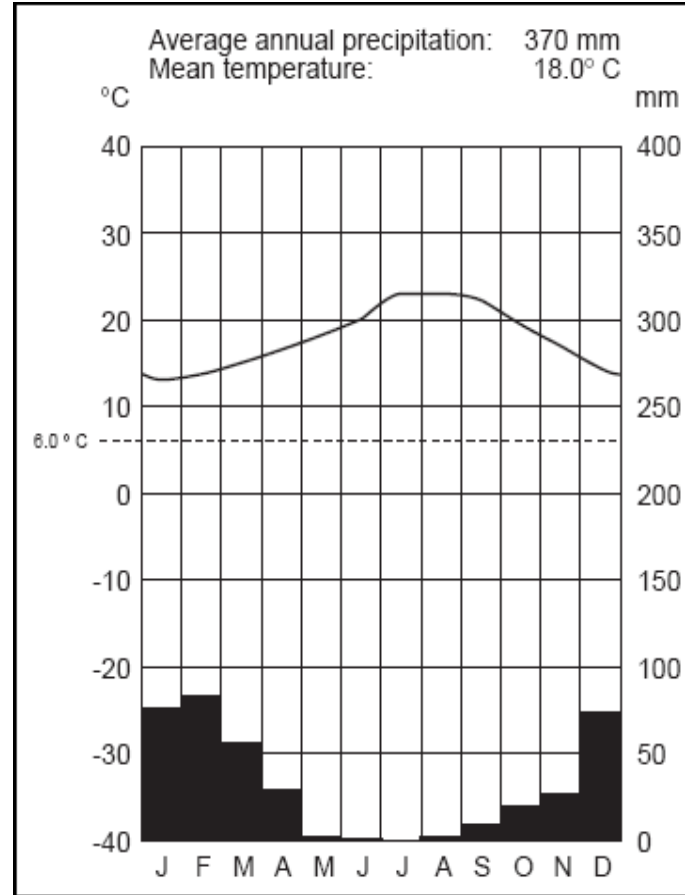


Coastal Climates: Moderate Temperature Ranges with Moderate Precipitation.

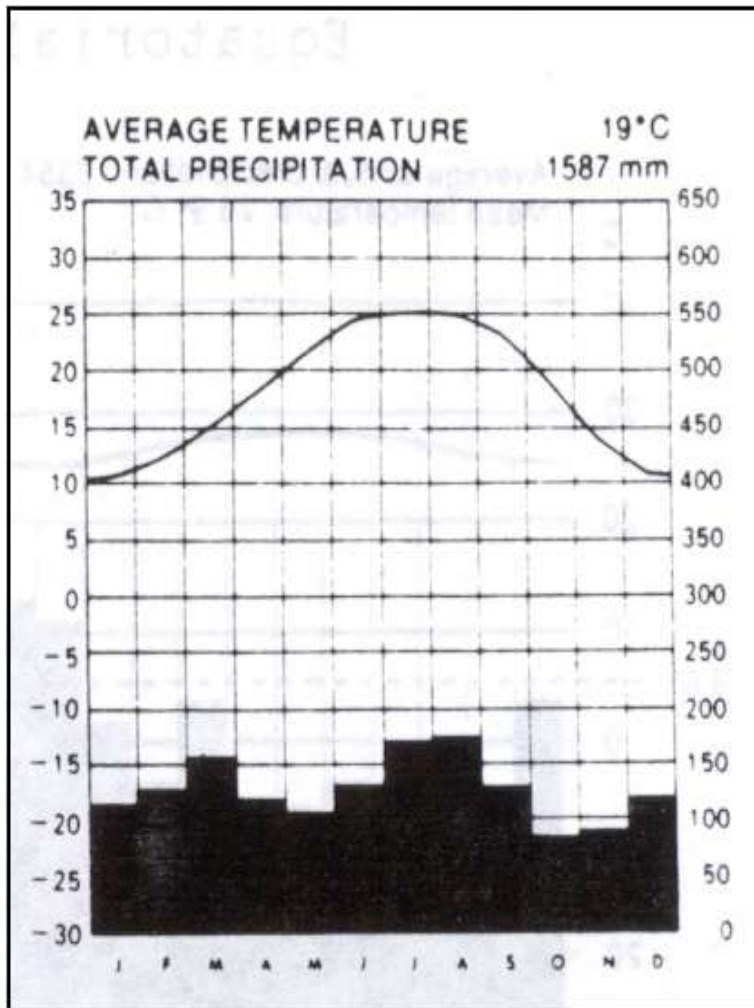
Cool Climate – Moderate Winter

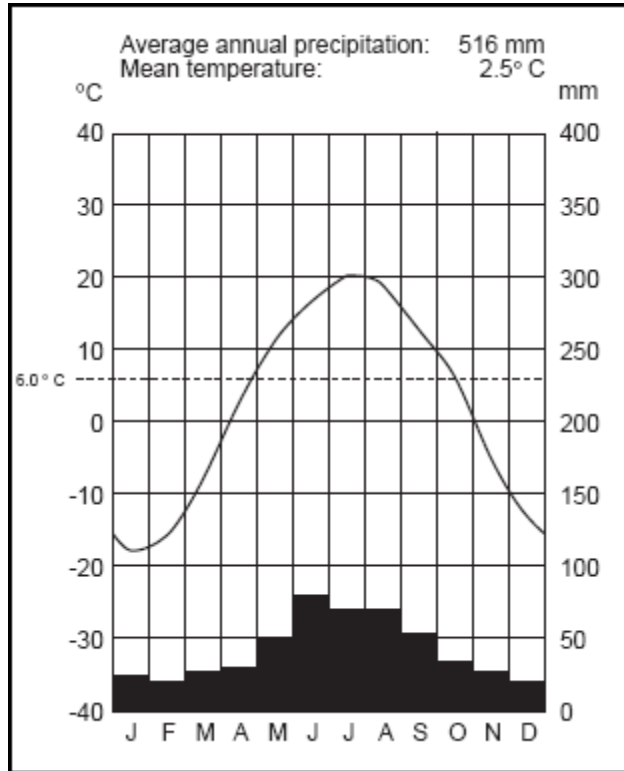


Warm Climate – Wet
